### Bar exam

2010 exam dates/location	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Tuesday, February 23 and Wednesday, February 24</li> <li>- Tuesday, July 27 and Wednesday, July 28</li> <li>- Exams given in Lincoln</li> </ul>
MEE subjects (MBE in bold)	Business Associations (Agency & Partnership and Corporations & LLCs), Conflict of Laws, <b>Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence</b> , Family Law, Federal Civil Procedure, <b>Real Property, Torts</b> , Trusts and Estates (Decedents' Estates and Trusts & Future Interests), and Uniform Commercial Code (Negotiable Instruments and Secured Transactions)
Structure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Tuesday = six MEE questions</li> <li>- Wednesday = MBE               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 200 total multiple choice questions (100 each administered in morning/afternoon)                   <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 33 questions in Contracts and Torts</li> <li>- 31 questions in Con Law, Criminal Law/Procedure, Evidence, and Real Property</li> </ul> </li> <li>- 190 graded questions, 10 experimental questions (indistinguishable)</li> <li>- 1.8 minutes per question</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Scoring	Candidates must achieve combined MEE/MBE score of 135
MPRE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Minimum passing score = 85</li> <li>- Candidates without passing score should include \$100 fee in addition to application fee</li> </ul>
Pass %	July 2008 = 89% first time takers, 85% all takers
Other	Laptop program available to all interested for \$150 fee (mail with exam application)
